Beloved Sisters and Brothers,

As we celebrate Thanksgiving this weekend, personally, there's so many things to give thanks for. Today I'd like first to **thank the Father for the Gift of Jesus.** This is what we do at every Mass, hence Mass is called Eucharistic Celebration. **Eucharist means thanksgiving.** This weekend, as we attend Mass, let us thank God again for His many blessings. 



Religious Freedom in the World Report 2023

Do you have a full picture of religious freedom in the world?

Since 1999, Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) has been publishing the Religious Freedom in the World Report - a global overview considering the status of this fundamental human right for all religious traditions. Published biennially, the publication reports on incidents gathered over the two-year period, revealing where the individual can freely choose and publicly express



his or her faith without being discriminated, oppressed, or persecuted.

Everyone has the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion [guaranteed and respected]; this right includes freedom to change his religion or belief, and freedom, either alone or in community with others and in public or private, to manifest his religion or belief in teaching, practice, worship and observance (Article 18 of The Universal Declaration of Human Rights).



Religious Freedom Report

The ACN report examines the state of religious freedom in 196 countries, runs to nearly 900 pages, and is published in six languages. It is one of four reports on the state of global religious freedom. The others are published by the American Pew Research Center, the U.S. State Department, and the United States Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF). The ACN report is the only non-governmental report in Europe that takes Catholic social doctrine into account.
