

Hello Everyone. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP) continues to be very busy. Over the summer we were privileged to take 103 calls for assistance; result-



ing in 54 hampers being delivered, referring 26 clients to other agencies, and helping with utility and transportation difficulties. Thank-you for your excellent support, we cannot help others without your continued assistance. We also thank the Knights of Columbus for supplying winter jackets through their Coats for Kids Programmed.. We are be-

ginning to plan for the Christmas season. The "Angel Tree" will be returning to the church foyer on the second weekend of November. Many families do not have the means to indulge their children, the Angel Tree helps overcome this. There will be Angel tags on the tree with a child's age and gender. We are all asked to take a tag or two, buy a gift appropriate to the information on the tag, and bring the *unwrapped* gifts back by the end of November. The gifts will be distributed to the children at the SSVP Christmas party on Dec. 9. Last year was a huge success. If you are unable to purchase a gift, perhaps it would be simpler to put a little extra in the SSVP donation envelope we have in our St. Pius X offertory envelope packages.

November 19, 2023 is the International Day Of The Poor. We are asking all our parishioners to go through their pantries and bring in any non-perishable food items they no longer need. No item is inconsequential. We know the St. Pius altruïsm will shine. Thank-you very much.
