Pastor's Message:

Prepare the Way of the Lord

This winter hasn't been that cold. It has given me the opportunity to go around the neighborhood and enjoy the Christmas lights. People really put in a lot of effort in making their houses look nice. It's beautiful and I can feel that Christmas is in the air. People are baking: I was in the kitchen to say hi to the ladies as they were busy baking for the Christmas bake sales (Check page 4 for details). They were very kind to me: they allowed me to taste some of the short bread and butter tat. The cookies were so good that I wanted another one, but they chased me out of the kitchen. □..... Not quite like that, but the way I was going, they might not have enough to sell on the weekend. I tasted love in the cookies. Our decoration crew have also taking some time in putting Advent decoration in our Church. These things make me happy. As we engage in these preparations, John the Baptist shows up in the Gospel today with a definitive invitation: Prepare the way of the Lord. He is calling us to the inner preparation: the preparation of our hearts and souls for Jesus this Christmas. This truly is the greatest preparation for Christmas.

As we prepare our houses, it really honours those who come to visit us this Christmas.

How can we prepare and honour the greatest GUEST this Advent and Christmas?

One of the great ways is by going to Confession where we show Jesus that we love Him, that we truly want Him to come to us in a new way this Christmas.

I remember years ago when I fell from a mango tree. I love mangoes but Mum had warned me to stop climbing. I didn't listen. I fell - so badly. She heard me crying, rushed to me, carried me back into the house. I remember her asking me with a tender voice: "Where does it hurt." That comforted me. She didn't shout and say: "I warned you." No. She ended up by asking; what do you want to eat?"

This is truly what Jesus does for us in Confession. He picks us up with great tenderness and comforts us as Isaiah says today (Comfort ye my people). He desires to heal us and bring us to the Eucharistic feast. Imagine what it will be like to receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist this Christmas after Christmas Confession. ...Continues page 2
