PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Society of St. Vincent de Paul 2023 Recap

Happy New Year St. Pius X!!!

2023 was a challenging year for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul here at St. Pius X. The need in our area increased substantially. Not only did we receive requests for food hampers, but also for help with utility, medical, children's summer programmes, and other expenses. Rent requests are handled by Invincible Housing a special project of the Okanagan Valley Particular Council of the SSVP. This is the umbrella Council for all the local Conferences here in the Central Okanagan.

In 2023 we received 525 calls to the St. Pius X SSVP phone. 79 of the callers were new clients looking for assistance. We delivered 199 hampers plus 90 Christmas hampers. As a result of these inquiries, 64 callers were referred to other organizations that were better suited to support their needs. We were blessed to be able to distribute 53 winter coats to children of families we support - courtesy of the Knights' of Columbus. In June we provided a barbecue and in December a turkey dinner to anyone who received aid in 2023.

Year over year our food expenses increased by 18% as did outlays for other needs. These expenditures would have been higher were it not for the extremely diligent efforts of our purchasers abilities to scan fliers and take advantage of sales and discounts. Food donations were a slightly lower. We would like to express our deep appreciation to the parishioners of St. Pius X and the students of Immaculata Regional High School for your truly generous foodstuffs donations. Monetary donations rose 0.5% from 2022. Thanks to the monies received from the Christmas Carol Festival and a private foundation the St. Pius X SSVP was able to virtually break even in 2023.

I am profoundly humbled by the generosity and support we received from our parishioners, the Knights of Columbus, Immaculata High School staff and students, and all the volunteers who give countless hours, energy, and treasure to help our less fortunate brothers and sisters. It is my prayer that our Lord continue to bless each and everyone of us. May His grace and mercy inspire us to spread his love to all. God Bless.
