St. Pius X Catechism Session Beginning September 2022

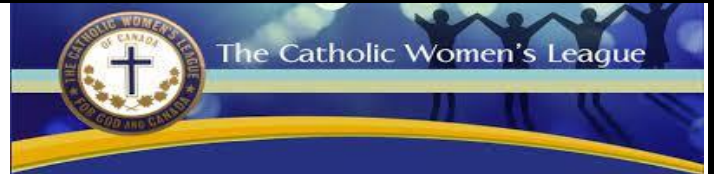
