Every fourth Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Good Shepherd Sunday. It is also known as the World Day of Prayer for Vocation. On this day we ask the Lord of the harvest to bless the Church



with vocation to the priesthood and concentrated life.

Vocation is not only about the priests and consecrated people, it is for everyone - for we are all called by God for a particular purpose and mission in life.

By the virtue of our baptism, every Christian is called to be a "good shepherd" in his environment: Parents must be good shepherds to their children edifying them with love. 

News Update

Greetings St. Pius X Parishioners! The following is an update to let you know what has been happening so far this year. The first three months of 2024 have been quite busy, we even had a couple of extra delivery days to keep up with requests. We received 122 calls, delivered 58 hampers, gave out \$4030 in gift and gas cards and utility relief, had 22 referrals, and assisted 24 new clients. The gift cards allow clients to buy fresh dairy products, vegetables, and fruit. Gas cards help clients attend medical appointments locally and sometimes Childrens' Hospital. At times, there is not enough money to go around and clients need help with their utility bills. Sometimes the requests we receive require more specialized assistance. That is when we refer folks to other organizations.

There is a great need for affordable housing in Kelowna. Many people walk a thin line between being housed or living on the street, especially those with special needs. Although our Society tries to help where it can, we still have to be diligent and prudent with our resources. To that end, our clients generally only qualify for our help no sooner than every three months.

We need your help. Parish donations have dropped, especially food donations. Please consider dropping off non-perishable foodstuffs in the St. Vincent de Paul bin located in the church foyer. The donation envelope package has a yellow envelope for St. Vincent de Paul on the first Sunday of the month. Please be as generous as possible. May Our Lord bless you for your benevolent charity. 
